

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROSEDALE NO. 283

BYLAW NO. 05/2020

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A LIMIT ON CASH COLLECTIONS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a) "Designated officer" shall mean
 - i) the person appointed as the Administrator of the municipality; or
 - ii) the person who has been delegated authority to collect and deposit cash receipts belonging to the municipality;
 - b) "Council" means the Council of the Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283;
 - c) "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283.
2. The designated officer shall deposit in the name of the Municipality, in the Royal Bank of Canada, Hanley, Saskatchewan, all moneys collected and receipted when they have accumulated to the amount of \$200,000.00.
3. At the discretion of the designated officer, deposits may be made more frequently but, in any case, not less than once a month nor more than once each day.
4. That Bylaw No. 4/2007 is hereby repealed.
5. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect from and after the day of final passing thereof.
