

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROSEDALE NO. 283

BYLAW NO. 06/2024

GENERAL ELECTION BYLAW

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE  
This Bylaw may be cited as “The Election Bylaw.”
2. AUTHORITY  
The authority for this Bylaw is section 9.1 of *The Local Government Election Act, 2015*.
3. PURPOSE  
The purpose of this Bylaw is to address matters which Council may decide by bylaw or resolution. It is to be used in conjunction with *The Local Government Election Act, 2015*.
4. DEFINITION  
In this Bylaw:
  - a) “Act” means *The Local Government Election Act, 2015*;
  - b) “Council” means the Reeve and Councillors of the Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283 elected pursuant to the provisions of *The Local Government Election Act, 2015*;
  - c) “Municipality” means the Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283;
  - d) Definitions from within *The Local Government Election Act, 2015* shall apply here.
5. ADVERTISING  
Advertising is to be completed as per section 9 of the Act. The following methods of advertising will be published as listed:
  - 5.1 Newspaper
    - a. All ads required to be published in a newspaper shall be in the Davidson Leader and The Outlook.
  - 5.2 Conspicuous Public Places:
    - a. Municipality’s Office – PT NW 36-30-04 W3
    - b. The office of the Returning Officer (If different than the Municipality’s Office)
    - c. Town of Hanley Community Hall Bulletin Board – 107 Lincoln Avenue, Hanley
    - d. Bulletin Board in front of the Hanley Post Office – 511 1<sup>st</sup> street, Hanley
  - 5.3 Electronic
    - a. The Municipality’s website.
6. DISCLOSURE OF CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS AND EXPENSES (section 34 of the Act)
  - 6.1 There will be no requirements for candidates to disclose contributions or expenses for a Municipal Election.
  - 6.2 There will be no election campaign spending limits established.
7. NOMINATION DAY  
Nomination day shall remain as stated in stated in clause 73(1)(a) of *The Act*.
8. CANDIDATES OCCUPATION (clause 9.1 (2)(c) of the Act)  
There will not be a requirement to list the candidate’s occupation on the nomination paper and ballot for a Municipal Election.
9. ELECTRONIC VOTING DEVICES (section 90 of the Act)  
Electronic voting devices will not be utilized by the municipality.

10. FORM OF BALLOTS (section 91 of the Act)  
Names on the ballot will be arranged in alphabetical order, using the format: last name, first name, as per clause 91(1)(d) of *The Act*.
11. MAIL-IN BALLOT SYSTEM (section 92 of the Act)  
Mail-in ballots will not be used for the Municipal Election.
12. TIE VOTE  
In the case of a tie vote a by-election shall be held pursuant to section 141.1 of *The Act*.
13. That Bylaw No. 04/2020 is hereby repealed.


