BYLAW NO. 20/2025

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF HANLEY RESPECTING THE CREATION AND OPERATION OF THE HANLEY ROSEDALE AGRICULTURAL & RECREATIONAL COMMITTEE

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283 is hereby authorized to enter into the agreement, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw, and identified as Schedule "A" with the Town of Hanley for the purpose stated within the agreement.
2. The Reeve and Administrator of the Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283 are hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached agreement identified as Schedule "A".
3. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect from and after the day of final passing thereof.

SCHEDULE "A"

Schedule "A" to Bylaw No. 20/2025

THIS AGREEMENT made in duplicate this 9 day of December, 20 25.

BETWEEN: **THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROSEDALE NO. 283,**
of P.O Box 150, Hanley, Saskatchewan, S0G 2E0
(hereinafter referred to as "Rosedale" of the First Part)

- and -

THE TOWN OF HANLEY,
of P.O. Box 270, Hanley, Saskatchewan, S0G 2E0
(hereinafter referred to as the "Hanley" of the Second Part)

(Collectively referred to as "the Parties.")

WHEREAS

The Parties desire to work cooperatively to promote and support recreational and agricultural opportunities for the benefit of their residents.

NOW THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESS AS FOLLOWS:

1. PURPOSE

This Agreement is made to formally establish The Hanley/Rosedale Agricultural & Recreational Committee ("the Committee") to promote, develop, and oversee one (1) annual agricultural and recreational community event.

2. FORMATION OF THE COMMITTEE

The Parties agree to jointly establish the Committee. It shall operate as a standing committee of council under the authority delegated by Hanley and its bylaws.

3. OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the Committee are to:

- a) Plan, promote, and coordinate an annual recreational and agricultural event; and
- b) generate revenue to maintain, upgrade, and expand the recreational and agricultural facilities of the Town of Hanley for the benefit of residents of both municipalities.

4. COMMITTEE COMPOSITION

1. The Committee shall be composed of:
 - a) Two (2) councillors or representatives appointed by the Council of Hanley;
 - b) Two (2) councillors or representatives appointed by the Council of Rosedale; and
 - c) Minimum of four (4) additional community members.
2. The Committee shall appoint from among its members a President, Secretary, and Treasurer.
3. Membership terms shall be for two (2) years.

5. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. The President shall chair all meetings of the Committee.
2. The Secretary shall record the minutes of all meetings.
3. The Treasurer shall maintain the Committee’s financial records and oversee all transactions.
4. The Committee shall meet at least quarterly.
5. Quorum shall consist of a majority of the members.
6. The President or any four (4) members may call a special meeting.
7. The Committee may pass internal bylaws or policies to regulate additional duties and responsibilities as deemed necessary.
8. The Committee shall comply with the Hanley Boards and Committees Bylaw and the Hanley Procedure Bylaw.

6. PROPERTY AND ASSETS

Any assets acquired by the Committee shall be deemed the property of the Town of Hanley. Upon dissolution of the Committee, all assets and liabilities shall be transferred to Hanley.

7. TERM AND TERMINATION

This Agreement shall take effect upon signing and shall remain in force until terminated. Either Party may terminate this Agreement by providing six (6) months’ written notice. Upon termination, all assets and liabilities shall be settled in accordance with Section 6.

8. AMENDMENTS

This Agreement may be amended only by the mutual written consent of both Parties.

9. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Agreement shall come into force when both Parties have approved and passed it by bylaw of Council.
