

BYLAW NO.6/2007

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROSEDALE NO.283 TO ESTABLISH A HAYING POLICY

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
 - a) "municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283
 - b) "road" means a "public highway" as defined by *The Municipalities Act*.

2. Conditions for the salvage of hay from a road in the municipality:
 - a) The adjacent landowner or lessee in the case of rented land, has first option to salvage hay along municipal roads. Other persons must contact the adjacent landowner or lessee to salvage the hay on or before July 15 each year.

 - b) After July 15, any person may cut and salvage hay without the permission of the adjacent landowner or lessee, provided the adjacent landowner or lessee has not begun salvage operations.

 - c) The right-of-way must be left in a neat appearance by the person salvaging the hay.

 - d) Bales of hay must be off the shoulder of the road.

 - e) All bales must be removed from the shoulder of the road on the day they are baled.

 - f) All bales must be removed from the right-of-way within one month of the baling of the hay.

 - g) The Council reserves the privilege and right for its members, employees and/or agents to enter upon said right-of-way for the maintenance and/or reconstruction of said road or for other such purposes as may be deemed necessary, and at no compensation or reimbursement to the party salvaging the hay therefrom.

 - h) The municipality assumes no liability for laborers, machinery or bales relating to the salvage of hay operations.

 - i) In order to minimize hazards to motorists, any bales not removed as per clauses d, e and f may be removed by the municipality and any bales so removed shall become the property of the municipality.

 - j) No person shall cut hay on any portion of a public highway located in this municipality during the period from one-half hour after sunset until one-half hour before sunrise.

 - k) No person shall cut hay on any portion of a public highway located in this municipality so as to obstruct the traveled portion of the public highway.


2. Bylaw No. 1/1991 is hereby repealed.
