## BYLAW NO. 03/2016

## A BYLAW FOR AN EXEMPTION FROM THE REQUIREMENTS FOR ROAD CROSSING FOR THE CN RAIL

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the "Exemption for Road Crossing" Bylaw.
- 2. To allow CN Railway's request for an exemption from the requirements of CROR rule 103(d) and sections 97(2) and 99 of the Grade Crossing Regulations, for the public road crossing located at west/east road, mile 121.45 on the Craik Subdivision (locally known as Patkau/Klassen road). The request will include periods of occupancy at the crossing of CN to be in excess of 5 minutes with a maximum occupancy of two hours.
- 3. The alternate route is via grid road 764.
- 4. Bylaw No. 2/2015 is hereby repealed.
- 5. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the final passing.
