

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROSEDALE NO. 283

BYLAW NO. 10/2019

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. This bylaw may be referenced as the "Speed Limit Bylaw"

PART I
PURPOSE AND DEFINITIONS

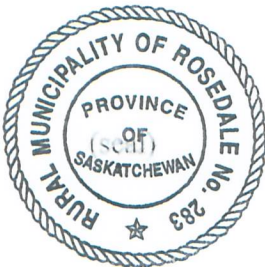
- 2. The purpose of this bylaw is to identify motor vehicle weight category within the Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283 for which speed limit is reduced and set out the penalties and/or fines for those persons who exceed the reduced speed limit on public highways.
3. In this bylaw:
a) "public highway" means a public highway as defined by The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997 under the direction, control and management of the Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283;
b) "motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle as defined by or pursuant to The Traffic Safety Act.

PART II
PROVISIONS

- 4. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than that posted on any public highways.
5. For motor vehicles weighing less than 10 tonnes, the speed limit on all public highways within the Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283 is 80 km/hr unless otherwise posted.
6. For motor vehicles weighing 10 tonnes or more, the speed limit on all public highways within the Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283 is 60 km/hr unless otherwise posted.

PART III
ENFORCEMENT

- 7. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a penalty of that identified in The Highway and Transportation Act 1997.
