

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROSEDALE NO. 283

BYLAW NO. 01/2022

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 3/99 KNOWN AS THE ZONING BYLAW UNDER SUBSECTION 46(3) OF THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2007.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Rosedale No. 283, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Section 5.3.2 – Agricultural District, subsection (4) Exemptions from minimum frontage and area requirements is amended by adding the following immediately after sub-subsection (b):  
  
“(c) Council may permit a lessor site size in order to accommodate sites fragmented from the balance of a quarter section by either natural (river, creek, coulie, etc.) or man-made (developed road, railway, etc.) barrier;
2. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the date it is approved by the Minister of Government Relations,
