Should Mr. Norheim fail or refuse to comply with this directive, the Municipality shall proceed with opening the crossing for inspection purposes and retain the \$2,500 deposit in accordance with the agreement. Should the road allowance not be restored to the required specifications following inspection, the Municipality shall complete the necessary work to bring the road allowance into compliance with Agreement 2026-01, with all associated costs to be borne by Mr. Norheim.
