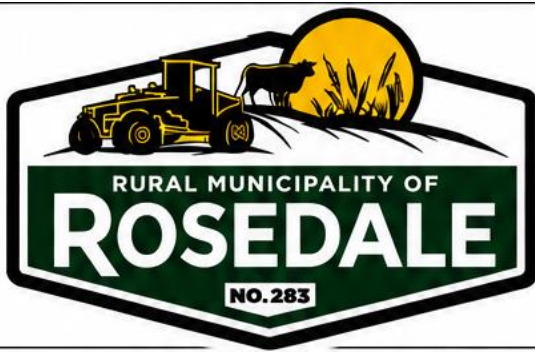

ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

- Reshaping approximately 5 miles of roadway
- Replacing or installing 6 culverts
- Replacing 2 Large Diameter culverts

- Crushing approximately 25,000 yards of road gravel
